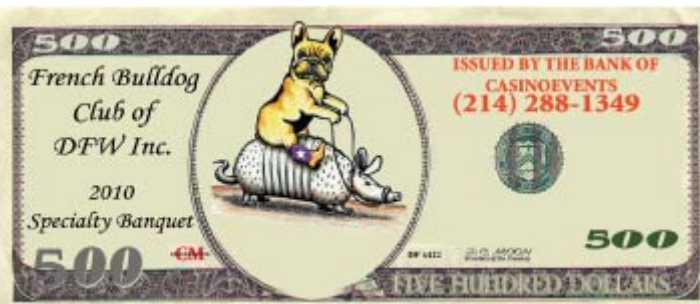

ATTENTION EXHIBITORS

AKC registerable French Bulldogs are eligible to enter.

No dog that is taped or bandaged will be judged.

Refer to Rules Applying to Registration and Dog Shows, Chapter 6, Section 4 through 8, for requirements for eligibility to enter the various classes.

With the exception of the Show Secretary, members of the French Bulldog Club of Dallas/Ft Worth are allowed to exhibit at this show.

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a veterinarian or judge or bared from competition by action of the bench show committee.

No entry fee will be refunded if the show cannot open or be completed by reasons of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes, or any other cause beyond the control of the club.

Telephone, and unsigned entries cannot be accepted. Entries without the agreement and rules on the reverse side are not acceptable.

Entries will not be accepted without the fees. Non Sufficient Funds checks or declined credit cards do not constitute a valid entry.

The show giving club and the show secretary assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children.
